



Yellow Fever Vaccination requirements

In order to avoid any inconvenient to your customers, we are requesting your collaboration reminding the customers who need to be vaccinated against Yellow Fever and who wish to enter Bolivia, Costa Rica, El Salvador and Honduras, where is an obligatory requirement to carry the corresponding "International Vaccination Certificate against Yellow Fever (CIV)".

Always for your convenience we are annexing a table detailing the countries which demand such requirement.

This measurement does not apply for in-transit customer by the countries which such a risk.

In Bolivia, Costa Rica, El Salvador and Honduras, customers could not board if they are are traveling towards the countries that demand the Vaccination and they will return to Bolivia, Costa Rica, El Salvador or Honduras if they have not been vaccinated at least 10 days before their departure.

Conditions:

- The "International Vaccination Certificate against Yellow Fever" must be presented in its original.
- The Yellow Fever vaccination must be applied at least 10 days before traveling.
- The "International Vaccination Certificate against Yellow Fever" is valid 10 days after the vaccination has been applied and it has a validation of 10 years.

Exceptions:

- Children younger than 12 months.
- Pregnant Women.

- Persons that do to their health condition, present an exemption of the vaccination against Yellow Fever, dully signed by an authorized medical official or an authorized health agent.
